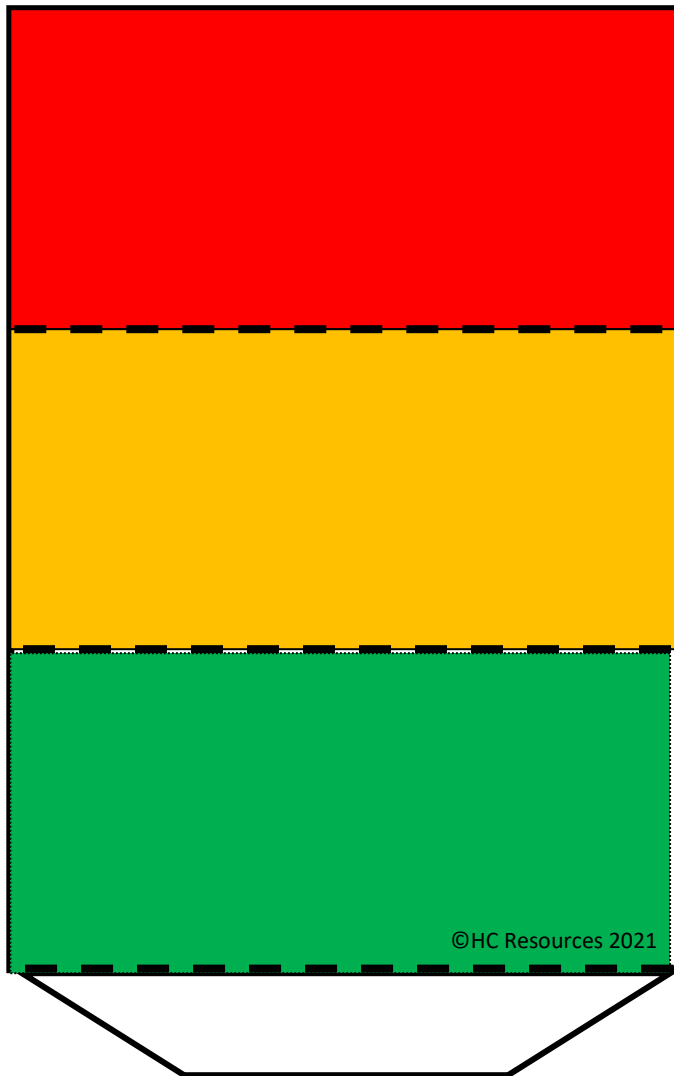




Free Resource: Desk Communication Pyramid



Uses

Once assembled this simple desktop communication tool can be used by pupils to tell the teacher or teaching assistant if they are ok (green), if they need some help, but can continue working on other things (orange) or if they are totally stuck (red). It can be used as an alternative to putting up a hand in class.

You can assign other meanings to the colours if you wish, just instruct users on the designated meaning of each colour.

Assembly

1. Print this page in colour, card is preferable.
2. Cut around the outside of the whole shape – including the white tab. Fold at the dotted lines.
3. Form into a pyramid shape and use glue to stick the front side of the tab to the inside of the red rectangle, or use tape if you prefer.
4. The tool is ready for use.
